Preparing Source Video

For most stable results: Convert all videos to MP4 container with MPEG4 video codec and FAAC audio codec:

```
$ ffmpeg -i <infile> -vcodec  
mpeg4 -sameq -acodec libfaac  
outfile.mp4
```
